

What do we do?

We provide a safe, happy place for parents to meet with their children after a breakup.



Why are we here?

Sometimes parents find it difficult after a breakup to find a way for the children to stay in contact with their non resident parent. We are here to help provide a relaxed, comfortable place where non resident parents enjoy time with their children.

We provide games and toys so that the visiting parent can have some fun with their children. Refreshments are provided.

Do I have to meet my former partner?

No, we can arrange for you to come in through different doors.



How are visits arranged?

You can refer yourself to the centre (phone 07792075972). Referrals are also made by solicitors, family court welfare officer, social worker or family mediator.

Are there any rules?

It is important that all children at the centre feel safe and can enjoy themselves, so there are a few rules, which we will tell you about when you come.



How often can I come?

This will be arranged between yourself, your former partner and any others involved.

Who are the helpers?

All our helpers are volunteers. They have been carefully chosen, and will not talk about you or your situation to anyone else. They all have to be checked by the DBS (formerly the Criminal Records Bureau,) to make sure that your children are safe. We do not take sides, or write reports about the children or their parents.

All mobile phones are handed in at the beginning of each session. This applies to everyone. If you need it during the session a helper will get it for you.


